Students will learn while working on a real project, on real film sets, doing the job, one-on-one with a mentor who is a working professional in the industry.








WIFT Academy is a mentorship program, pairing accomplished members of the film community with burgeoning filmmakers. From pre-production to post, all elements of filmmaking will be explored, including scriptwriting, directing, line producing, production coordination, lighting, sound, music, editing and more.







The program, which begins August 2024, is three months long, with a month dedicated to Pre-production, a month to Production and a month to Post.



PRE-PRODUCTION

- Areas covered during Preproduction include:
- Film Budgeting
- Breaking down the script
- Storyboarding & Shotlists
- Location selection
- Permits & Insurance
- Casting
- Scheduling





PRODUCTION

In September, we will begin principal photography, and the following areas will be addressed:

- Directing
- Cinematography
- Script Supervision
- And "below the line" positions including
- Camera operator
- Production Assistants
- Assistant directors
- Props & scenery
- Hair, make-up & wardrobe
- Audio
- Lighting



In October, we will finish the project during Postproduction. Areas addressed will include:

- Video Editing
- Sound Editing
- Music
- Special effects & Correction
- Pick-up shooting
- Voiceover & ADR

Additionally, we will cover marketing, advertising and distribution.



FILM FESTIVALS

The last stage of the Academy will be Film Festival Submission, teaching new filmmakers how to submit to local festivals and ultimately enjoying the full Film Festival experience.
